ERICH MENDELSOHN AWARD 2023 FOR BRICK ARCHITECTURE

WANTED: THE BEST BUILDINGS MADE FROM BRICK

The sixth Award for Brick Architecture will be dedicated to the visionary architect Erich Mendelsohn. It will honor distinguished achievements in construction and design that best showcase a special building material.

The Erich Mendelsohn Award 2023 for Brick Architecture recognizes projects that are building bridges and use the potential of a traditional resource sustainably and future-proof to create special and remarkable pieces of architecture. Brick is the generic term for façade bricks fired from clay, which are also known as facing bricks or clinker bricks. Since 2008 the Award for Brick Architecture was held every three years and in that time has grown into one of the largest German architectural awards with more than 600 national and international entries.

The competition is looking for entrants that exhibit impressive brick architecture and create a tangible added value – either in economic, ecological, creative, or functional terms. This appears in in the way details are worked out, in simplicity and uniformity, in the structure of the façade, in its color, and other aspects – regardless of the size of the building or its character. Does your reference convince, surprise and demand to be seen? The Brick Building Initiative and the jury are looking forward to your entry.


The Erich Mendelsohn Award for Brick Architecture is and remains an independent, non-commercial architectural competition – even if a participation fee is being charged since 2020. It only serves to cover the increased administrative costs. All fees are used for the award as an investment into the attractiveness of its public image and the quality of its publications. And ultimately, as awardwinners the architects will benefit from the reputation the award has developed.

INFORMATION CONCERNING PARTICIPATION

CATEGORIES

Prizes will be awarded to projects in the following categories:

- Detached house/semi-detached house
- Residential building/apartment complex
- · Office and commercial buildings
- Public buildings, recreation and sport

Additional awards will be presented for:

• Renovation/Sustainability/Energy efficiency

In addition, the Newcomer Award for emerging architects will be awarded for the fourth time.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

The competition awards a total of EUR 10.000. The prize money is divided up as follows:

Grand Prix: EUR 4.000

Gold Winner: EUR 1.000 in each category

It is at the discretion of the jury to distribute the prize money in a different manner.

COMPETITION AND DECISION

An independent jury of experts, whose members are appointed by the initiators of the Erich Mendelsohn Award, judges the entries submitted. The jury meets in camera. The winners are notified after a decision has been reached. The awards ceremony will be held in Berlin in the autumn of 2023.

JURY

The final composition of the high-caliber expert jury has not yet been decided. The participation of the following members has so far been confirmed:

- Susanne Wartzeck, President of the Association of German Architects BDA
- Ulrich Brinkmann, architect and editor of the architectural magazine Bauwelt

TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

Those eligible to take part include architects, architectural teams and architectural/engineering teams, provided they are the intellectual creators of the buildings entered. Entries must meet the following requirements:

1. Design: For a building to be eligible, it has to employ bricks in a distinctive fashion, so that the particular architectural properties and the immense potential of the material are showcased.

2. Completion: A building is only eligible for submission if it has been completed after 01/01/2018. Buildings that were previously submitted for the Fritz Höger Award 2020 may be resubmitted, provided they have been completed after 01/01/2018 and were not nominated for the Fritz Höger Award 2020

Submission period: 01/09/2023 - 04/30/2023

The documents for participation can only be submitted online at erich-mendelsohn-preis.com/entry

Participation fee

A participation fee will be charged for the Erich Mendelsohn Award 2023 for Brick Architecture and is due upon submission. It will be used exclusively to cover the increased administrative costs and to maintain and enhance the usual high quality of external communications. The Newcomer Award is exempted from the participation fee.

The participation fee applies to each project upon submission at **erich-mendelsohn-preis.com/entry**Our reduced early-bird fee of EUR 159 applies until February 28, 2023. The regular fee of EUR 197 will be charged from March 1, 2023.

SIMPLY SUBMIT YOUR ENTRY ONLINE

GENERAL

You can submit your entry for the Erich Mendelsohn Award 2023 for Brick Architecture directly and exclusively online at erich-mendelsohn-preis.com/entry Ideally, it will include the following documents:

1. DESCRIPTION/PROJECT DATA/CV

- · Project data
- Brief description
- Detailed project description (length 1.200 to 3.000 characters)
- Information about architects or architects' office

2.IMAGES/PLANS

- Images: 4 to 12 impactful photos of the property (incl. copyright)
- Plans: location map, floor plan, elevations, perspective views, façade cross section
- Additional material (optional): details, sketches, model photos, etc.

ONLINE SUBMISSION

Entries for the Erich Mendelsohn Award 2023 for Brick Architecture can only be submitted online. A participation fee will be charged for the submission of each project. You are able to temporarily save entries at any time and resume as often as you like at a later date up to the final submission of the project.
