

Participate until the end of May
Extension of submission phase

BERLIN. The Fritz Hoeger Award 2020 for Brick Architecture focuses on fairness and cohesion in times of Corona and extends the participation period by one month.

Since its first round in 2008, the prize has had a strong and constantly growing community of participants. With more than 600 submissions in the last year, the competition has become one of the biggest and most relevant German and European architecture prizes. Particularly in these challenging times, the Initiative Bauen mit Backstein, as initiator of the prize, attaches importance to fair competition and respectful treatment and has therefore extended the deadline for registration and submission of the material until May 29.

The Initiative thus enables architects – especially international ones – despite the current extensive work restrictions to participate equally and to submit their projects on time. Even those who have not been able to complete the submission documents or to register their own brick project yet can still look forward to win an award and the prize money of 10,000 euros in total.

About the Fritz Hoeger Award 2020 for Brick Architecture:

The Fritz Hoeger Award for Brick Architecture was launched in 2008 and honours outstanding accomplishments involving construction with a particular building material. It is awarded every three years and has been supported by its partner the Association of German Architects (BDA), since 2011.
